335 Sauvignon (Barton & Joyeux) 2019 // 13% // Grape - Sauvignon Blanc // Region - Bordeaux (AOC), France

£5.1 Medium // £7.3 Large // £14.7 Half Carafe // £22 Full Carafe

Originally from France, this traditional Sauvignon Blanc is zesty citrus and fresh grass on the nose, with a lovely dash of exotic fruits. Creamy rounded spice note on the palate with an intense lemon flavour. An ideal all rounder for sampling with our menus

Verdejo (Bodegas Latue) 2023 // 13% // Grape - Verdejo // Region - Toledo, Spain

£5.6 Medium // £8 Large // £24 Bottle

The Verdejo grape originated in North Africa and was first planted in Spain in the 11th Century. Originally used to make an oxidative, Sherry-style wine, today Verdejo is made in a fresh, crisp, fruit forward style. Intense aromas of ripe tropical fruits, grapefruit and aromatic spices. Crisp, zesty and if you like Sauvignon Blanc then you will like this fantastic new addition from Bodegas Latue. This wine works perfectly with the 'From the earth' and 'From the sea' sections of our menu

Gruner Veltliner (Meinklang Estate) 2022 12% // Grape - Gruner Veltliner // Region - Meinklang, Burgenland, Austria

£34.2 Bottle

Gruner Veltliner is an Austrian grape variety that's made Burgundian Chardonnay's look positively bland at international competitions, wowed the wine critics and is adored by sommeliers for its great food-matching credentials and yet despite all this, not everybody's heard about it. Well, here's your chance to see what all the fuss is about. It's got a lovely, citrus, mineral freshness and a really fun, white pepper pick-me-up finish. Another wine that shows how exciting wines from Austria are. This wine will stand up to some of the spicier dishes on our menu and work well with the game pie, angus tartare and even the smoked short rib

RED

Tempranillo (Pagos de Familia Tolosa) 2022 // 13% // Grape - Tempranillo // Region - La Mancha, Spain

£5.1 Medium // £7.3 Large // £14.7 Half Carafe // £22 Full Carafe

A bright, medium-bodied wine. Fruity with ripe red and black fruits: blackberry, red cherry and wild strawberry - silky, and well structured with soft tannins and a persistent finish. ORGANIC / VEGAN

Black Label (Bodegas Piqueras) 2021/22 // 14% // Grape - Monastrell & Syrah // Region - Almansa, Spain

£5.6 Medium // £8 Large // £24 Bottle

This rich red is made from 50% Monastrell and 50% Syrah and aged for 4-6 months in 300 litre, fine grain oak barrels. Medium-bodied on the palate with flavours of ripe red cherries, raspberries, crushed boysenberries, red plums, and a touch of vanilla spice on the nose. Lively and elegant with a silky finish. Best enjoyed with the 'From the earth' and 'From the land' sections of our menu but will not be too punchy to pair with the mussels or Monkfish.

Luna Gaia (Cantina Orsogna) 2022 // 12.5% // Grape - Nerello Mascalese // Region - Abruzzo, Italy
£33 Bottle

This 2022 vintage packs a punch. Nerello Mascalese is Sicily's star variety and usually grown around the foot of Mount Etna. These mineral-rich volcanic soils help the vines produce grapes that are rich in both complex minerals and a fine acidity. This exciting red has smoky minerality with rich red cherry fruit and a nimble body that dances along the palate. This wine's colourful label pays homage to the Sicilian puppet opera, a historical storytelling tradition in Sicily.

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ROSE

Bohem Rosé (Bodegas Latue Bohem) 2023 // 13% // Grape - Tempranillo // Region - La Mancha, Spain

£5.2 Medium // £7.4 Large // £22.2 Bottle

Organic-certified pink from the hillside vineyards of Bodegas Latúe. It is a typically deeply coloured Spanish rosé, so unlike the in-vogue Provence pale style, but that's a good thing with just too many look-alikes flooding the shelves. This has an inviting strawberries and cream nose, a little touch of cappuccino adding to the appeal. In the mouth is it perhaps just flirting with off-dry? But a sweep of that pulpy strawberry fruit, good acidity and a bit of Tempranillo spice gives a savoury finish. This rosé can stand up to almost all of the menu, best enjoyed with Sisu bread and the Cambridgeshire beetroot tartare.

Rosé Fruité (Château de Rousset) 2023 // 12.5% // Grape - Grenache, Syrah, Vermentino // Region - Chateau de Rousset, France

£30 Bottle

With its delicate salmon pink colour, this thrilling rosé surely has one foot firmly in the Provence camp. Grenache, Syrah and Vermentino predominate, providing a delicate, elegant wine with a soft, smooth mouthfeel. The red berried flavours come through and are carried on fresh and crisp balancing acidity. A rosé with flair and finesse, that will please all that try it. Pair this wine with the king scallop ceviche for a taste sensation.

ORANGE

El Troyano (Parra Jimenez) 2023 // 11.5% // Grape - Verdejo // Region - La Mancha - Spain //

£6.3 Medium // £9 Large // £27 Bottle

A great introduction to 'orange wine'. Essentially a white wine that has been in contact or fermented on its skins (normally removed). This example is made from Verdejo grapes, macerated in 200 litre clay amphora and large French oak vats. Pump overs help extract the amber colours and lees ageing adds smoothness and complexity. The result is an intriguing and refreshing wine with aromas of peach and orange. On the palate, it is savoury and persistent, with marked acidity and delicate hints of vanilla and spice. A great allrounder for our menu, best enjoyed in good company.

Rare Orange (Chateau Maris) 2022 // 13.5% // Grape - Muscat // Region - Languedoc-Roussillon, France // £34.8

The Muscat grapes are made with prolonged skin contact and fermented at red wine temperatures. This gives the wine a deeper colour, more flavour, and a very slight tannic sensation. A very fresh orange wine with bright notes of summer fruits including white peach, apricot and candied fruit flavours. Dry with a little presence of tannin on the finish. Drink this wine with the celeriac, short ribs for a wild ride or pair with cheese at the end of your meal.

FIZZ

Pet Nat Bianco (Integro Colline Pescaresi) NV // 12% // Grape - Chardonnay // Region - Abruzzo, Italy // £39

An organic Chardonnay Frizzante without sulphite or added sugar. A fresh sparkling wine that sometimes has a cloudy appearance as unfiltered natural fermentation. Unique straw colour with fragrant nose it has a purity of expression and panache. Lively fizz at every sip!

Pet Nat Rosé (Integro Colline Pescaresi) NV // 12% // Grape - Cabernet // Region - Abruzzo, Italy // £39

Unique cherry colour with intense fragrant fruity nose with marked notes of pomegranate and cherry. This Sparkling rose has a purity of expression fresh and sapid with good persistence and fruity aftertaste. Excellent as an aperitif, with our marinated olives, Jamon Serrano or with the 'From the earth' section of our menu.

Fleury (Champagne Fleury) NV // 12% // Grape - Pinot Noir, Chardonnay // Region - Champagne, France // £60

The first ever biodynamic cuvée in Champagne! Europe, which witnessed the fall of the Berlin Wall, inspired the name of this wine. 85% Pinot Noir and 15% Chardonnay, the ethereal and floral Chardonnay brings a special elegance to this cuvée. Despite at first receiving a dosage, it has been zero-dosage for the last 10 years. A bright gold robe carries aromas of honey and acacia with a mouthfeel that's ample and generous with a surprising freshness. This is a chiselled wine, mouth-wateringly vibrant, with a touch of salinity. Perfect for celebrating at Nowhere.
